A local law amending § 60-2, Responsibility of owner, of chapter 60, Brush, Grass and Weeds, of the Code of the Village of Kings Point.

Section 1. § 60-2, Responsibility of owner, of chapter 60, Brush, Grass and Weeds, of the Code of the Village of Kings Point, is hereby amended to read as follows:

“§ 60-2. Responsibility of owner.

A. Definitions.

For the purposes of this section, the following terms, phrases, and words shall have the following meanings:

ROAD – a street, highway, or right of way owned by a municipality.

UNPAVED ROAD AREA – the unpaved portion of a road lying between the paved portion of the road and an owner’s property line.

- B. It shall be the responsibility of every owner of land within the Village that abuts a road to maintain the unpaved road area abutting that owner's land so that:
- (1) grass, weeds, and other groundcover are not in excess of 6 inches in height;
 - (2) there are no unsightly, noxious, or otherwise dangerous accumulations of leaves, grass, bush clippings, fallen tree limbs, or other vegetation;
 - (3) hedges and shrubs are properly pruned or trimmed; and
 - (4) it is free of garbage and refuse, as such terms are defined in § 94-10 of this code.
- C. In the event an owner of land believes that a tree on an unpaved road area for which it is responsible is diseased, dead, or requires pruning, the owner shall contact the Superintendent of the Village Building Department. Such owner is not permitted to remove or substantially alter a tree on an unpaved road area.”

Section 2. Effective date. This local law shall take effect immediately.
